







Scholarship Schemes for Students

E-Kalyan Scholarship for the students of Jharkhand (Unisex)

Students can apply for e-kalyan Jharkhand scholarship 2023 on the official website - ekalyan.cgg.gov.in. This year, the pre-matric and post-matric scholarship scheme applications are expected to begin from February every year. The Registration of Pre-Matric applications through schools (within state) are ongoing. Students should track the official website to apply and get the latest updates on the same and complete the process before the ekalyan last date 2023.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students need to have a domicile certificate of Jharkhand.
- The scholarship is available for meritorious students of SC/ST and backward classes.
- The family income of the SC/ST student must be less than INR 2.5 lakh per annum.
- The family income of the backward class student should be less than 1.5 lakh per annum.

Other Miscellaneous terms:

- Students must provide their AADHAAR linked bank account details, while applying. (Domicile Required)
- Students belonging to SC,ST and BC in Jharkhand are eligible to apply for pre-matric scholarships.
- The scholarship will be awarded for studies in Jharkhand in government schools from class I to class X.
- The scholarship will be open from the month of October till February.

BCCL Ke Laal and BCCL Ki Laadli Scholarship, Jharkhand (For Students in Class 10th) (Unisex)

The BCCL Ke Laal and BCCL Ki Laadli Scholarship is a scholarship program for students in Jharkhand who are studying in the 10th standard. It is one of the most prestigious scholarships in the state, and it is awarded to students who have excelled in their studies. The

scholarship is sponsored by the Bharat Coking Coal Limited (BCCL), and it is administered by the Career Guidance Centre of the Department of Education, Government of Jharkhand. The scholarship covers the cost of tuition, hostel fees, maintenance allowance, and book allowance.

Eligibility criteria:

(This criterion is for 2023, the 2024 scholarship has not been rolled out yet)

- Class 10th Student.
- Residents of Jharkhand or wards of BCCL employees.
- BCCL command areas are within a 25-kilometer radius.
- It will be given preference to those with incomes under INR 6 lakhs.
- Pass the 10th board examinations with at least 60% marks.
- Free of chronic diseases.
- At the time of admission, the management will conduct medical fitness tests.

Additional details:

- The scholarship is open to students from all backgrounds, including SCs, STs, OBCs, and minorities.
- The scholarship is awarded on merit, and there is no reservation for any category.
- The scholarship is awarded for a period of one year, and it can be renewed for a further period of one year if the student maintains their academic performance.

National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (Unisex Central Scholarship)

The Central Sector Scheme 'National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme' was launched in 2008, after getting approval from CCEA, with the objective to award scholarships to meritorious students of economically weaker sections to arrest their drop out at class VIII and encourage them to continue their education at secondary stage. One lakh fresh scholarship is awarded to selected students of class IX every year and their continuation / renewal in classes X to XII for study in State Government, Government-aided and Local body schools under the

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scheme. The amount of scholarship is Rs. 12000/- per annum from 1st April 2017 (earlier it

was Rs. 6000/- per annum).

Eligibility criteria:

Students whose parental income from all sources is not more than Rs. 3,50,000/- per annum

are eligible to avail the scholarship. The students must have a minimum of 55 % marks or

equivalent grade in Class VII examination for appearing in the selection test for award of

scholarship (relaxable by 5% for SC/ST students). The students should be studying as regular

students in a Government, Government-aided and local body school. Students of NVS, KVS

and residential schools are not entitled for the scholarship. There is reservation as per State

Government norms

Selection of fresh Awardee Students:

Each State/UT conducts its own test for selection of students for the award of the National

Means-cum-Merit Scholarship. The test is conducted at the stage of class-VIII. The students,

who fulfill the eligibility criteria, must pass both the tests, i.e., Mental Ability Test (MAT)

and Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) under NMMSS exam with at least 40 % marks in

aggregate taken together for these two tests. For the SC/ST students, this cut off is 32%

marks.

Selection of Renewal Awardees Students:

• The awardees should get a minimum of 60% marks in Class X for continuation of

scholarship (relaxable by 5% for SC/ST candidates) in next higher classes.

• For continuing the scholarship in class X and XII, the awardees should get a clear

promotion from class IX to class X and from class XI to class XII in the first attempt.

- The students of the Begum Hazrat Mahal Scholarship are girl's students belong to minority communities (Muslims, Christians, Jains, Buddhists, Sikhs, and Parsis)
- Students studying from class 9th to 12th can apply for this scholarship scheme
- For this scholarship scheme, the student must obtain at least 50% marks or equivalent previous examination.
- The candidates must have to be verified by the school/ college. The candidates have to fill out the school verification form (Bonafide certificate) and get it signed by the principal along with a stamp and signature on the photograph.
- The student's family's annual income should not exceed INR 2 lakh.
- There is no need to send any hard copies to the scheme authority.
- Only two candidates apply for this scheme from a family.
- The applicants do not need to pay any fees for submitting the online application form.

Required Documents:

- Applicants Aadhaar card
- Annual family Income certificate
- Application School verification form
- Students' passport-size photograph
- Applicant's Previous year mark sheet
- Students' Self-declaration of the minority community
- Candidates' Bank account details

NSP Pre Matric Scholarship: (Unisex)

NSP Pre Matric Scholarship 2022-23: Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India invites Candidates from the students of Class 1 to 10 of minority communities for NSP Pre Matric Scholarship 2022-23 Scheme for Minorities scheme. The scholarship intends to energise guardians of minority communities to send their children to school by assisting them

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with subsidising the school instruction of their youngsters and by supporting the effort of teaching their kids.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible, Students must be:

- Candidates must be studying in Class 1 to 10th.
- Candidates must have secured at least 50% marks in the previous year.
- Annual family income of not more than INR 1 lakh per annual from all sources.
- Applicants belonging to the minority community (Muslims, Sikhs, Isai, Jains, Christians, Buddhists, and Zoroastrians/Parsis).

Required Documents:

- Candidates Domicile Certificate
- Self-community certificate by the student- download
- Students self-attested copy of previous year mark sheet
- Students Aadhar Enrollment/Aadhar Card
- Family Income certificate issued by a competent authority in the State/UT Government.
- Bank account in the name of the student or joint account with mother/father.

Scholarship Benefits:

- School Admission fee for Class 6 to 10 (Hostellers and Day Scholars): INR 500 per annum
- Student's tuition fee for Class 6 to 10 (Hostellers and Day Scholars): INR 350 per month
- School maintenance allowance for 10 months in an academic year (Day Scholars): INR 100 per month for Class 1 to 5
- School maintenance allowance for 10 months in an academic year (Hostellers): INR 600 per month for Class 6 to 10
- School maintenance allowance for 10 months in an academic year (Day Scholars): INR 100 per month for Class 6 to 10
- Scholarship Amount:
- 1,000 to 12,000 (1 to 10th Class wise or School tuition Fee wise Distributed).
